DENSO North America Travel Guidelines

Information for Domestic Travel (within own country)

Note: Federal, State or Local travel orders/restrictions always take precedence over DENSO's policy.

No special approval process is required for all travel within your own country. Please follow the established travel approval policy.

Information for International Travel (travel outside own country)


Note: Federal, State or Local travel orders/restrictions always take precedence over DENSO's policy.

Please follow the established travel approval policy per site.

Prior to international travel (either by plane or by car), associate and leader should consider the following:

- Check your destination's COVID-19 situation and travel requirements before traveling. Countries may have their own entry and exit requirements. Two sources are:

- Follow the safety protocols of the facility you are visiting, or follow DENSO's protocols if stricter. If you are not comfortable with the safety protocols at the destination, contact your management.

Entry Requirements (for common countries, others please refer to Concur for guidance):

United States (as of June 12, 2022)

CDC will no longer require air passengers traveling from a foreign country to the United States to show a negative COVID-19 viral test or documentation of recovery from COVID-19 before they board their flight.

Under CDC's Amended Order: Noncitizen nonimmigrants are still required to show proof of vaccination against COVID-19 before boarding a flight to the United States. DENSO does not require documentation of vaccination status before returning onsite at DENSO.

Canada (as of June 12, 2022)

You must use ArriveCAN to provide mandatory travel and public health information before and after your entry into Canada. All travelers, with limited exceptions, whether entering Canada by air, land, rail or marine vessel, must use ArriveCAN unless you're exempt from this requirement due to an accessibility need. You'll need to submit your information within 72 hours before your arrival to Canada.

Mexico (as of June 13, 2022)

There are no entry restrictions in Mexico and no obligation to carry a COVID test or to do quarantine. However, it is mandatory to register on the Mexico Vuela Seguro Platform before boarding and to show the QR code at the arrival airport.

Japan (as of June 12, 2022)

Eligible travelers from the United States to Japan, regardless of their vaccination status, will no longer require COVID-19 testing and quarantine upon arrival. Pre-travel testing within 72 hours of departure is still required. Travelers from countries other than the United States, or who have spent time in other countries in the 14 days prior to travel to Japan, may be subject to on-arrival COVID-19 testing and quarantine.

Personal Travel

DENSO recommends you follow the best practices outlined for business travel. Follow your site's return to work protocol.

Safe Travel Recommendations

- If you are informed that you were exposed to someone with symptoms or a confirmed case of COVID-19, call the local DENSO affiliate for advice and contact your leader.
- Stay informed on the latest developments about Coronavirus where you are. Follow advice given by the local government or public health authority.
